Coronary Artery Disease

- ▼ Shortness of Breath
- ▼ Palpitations
- ▼ Weakness/dizziness
- ▼ Nausea
- ▼ Sweating



Coronary heart disease (CHD) is a disease in which a waxy substance called plaque builds up inside the coronary arteries. These arteries supply oxygen-rich blood to your heart muscle.

Heart Attack

- ▼ Discomfort, pressure, heaviness or pain in the chest, arm of below the breastbone.
- ▼ Discomfort radiating to the back, jaw, throat, or arm
- ▼ Fullness, indigestion or choking feeling (may feel like heartburn)
- ▼ Extreme weakness, anxiety or shortness of breath
- ▼ Rapid or irregular heartbeats



A heart attack usually occurs when a blood clot blocks blood flow to the heart. Without blood, tissue loses oxygen and dies.
